Dear Mill Neck Residents,

On Friday, December 22, 2017, Governor Andrew M. Cuomo issued an Executive Order allowing prepayments of 2018 taxes to some municipalities that normally cannot accept payments before January 1, 2018. Several questions have arisen with respect to these prepayments and, in particular, to the applicability of the Governor's Order to our Village taxes.

NYCOM (New York Conference of Mayors) has informed us that this Order only impacts cities and villages with a January 1 fiscal year who normally collect taxes in the month of January. The Village of Mill Neck along with many other municipalities, have a June 1 to May 31 fiscal year. As the Village of Mill Neck's 2018-19 Village taxes will be collected beginning June 1, 2018, the Order does not apply to our Village taxes.

General tax and School taxes have a different due date. Therefore, the Town of Oyster Bay has stated it will accept second half school tax payments and General tax payments for 2018 by mail if postmarked by December 31, 2017. You may also pay in person today through Friday from 9am to 7 pm and Saturday from 9am to 3 pm at the Town Hall, 74 Audrey Ave, Oyster Bay, NY 11771. Any questions for the Town Receiver of Taxes can be directed to (516) 624-6400. The best way to find your 2018 Town taxes is to go on the Town of Oyster Bay website ([oysterbaytown.com/receiver of taxes](http://oysterbaytown.com/receiver-of-taxes)) using your Section , Block and Lot for your property.
