

VILLAGE OF MILL NECK WEST SHORE ROAD UPDATE

Phase III

October 6, 2017

The Third and final phase of the West Shore Road project is under way. The plans for the project are posted on the Village's website (www.millneckvillage.com). **A new completion date in December is on Nassau County's update.** An earlier completion date is anticipated as the contractor G&M Earth Moving, Inc. continues to perform ahead of the posted schedule.

They have completed the installation of the plantings and will finish mulching next week. Railing installation continues. The installation of the guardrail has begun. The concrete work has been completed with the exception of where the guardrail has yet to be installed. There will be five openings through the guardrails for access to the path including one across from Sea View Drive and one across from The Concourse. They should be installing the three approved stairs for the private beach access points next week.

The final layer of paving will be installed on West shore Road Phase III most likely during late October. On this day, there will be restrictions on access. We will be notifying the residents along West Shore Road as soon as we are notified of the date and restrictions.

West Shore Road will be open **DURING NON-WORKING HOURS**. During the workweek, the road open schedule will be in accordance with the schedule below. **The posted speed limit is 20 MPH, at all times**, due to this phase still being an active construction zone. Traffic tickets issued will result in fines that will be doubled. Police will be enforcing the speed limit for safety of all involved.

- The stop light at West Shore Road and Cleft Road is operational. A reminder there is No Right Turn on red from Cleft Road.
- During the work days next week, the road will be closed during the following schedule:

9:00 AM – 3:30 PM SOUTH BOUND LANE
9:00 AM – 3:30 PM NORTH BOUND LANE

Residents who live on The Concourse and north of The Concourse will go north.
Residents who live south of The Concourse will go south.

- **G & M will not be working this weekend.**
- For the resident's information, any time the Bayville Bridge is not passable, emergency services are notified to ensure timely responses by Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services. **The anticipated start date for the project on the Bayville Bridge is not until the fall of 2018 at the earliest.**
