

VILLAGE OF MILL NECK WEST SHORE ROAD UPDATE

Phase III

August 4, 2017

The Third and final phase of the West Shore Road project is under way. The plans for the project are posted on the Village's website (www.millneckvillage.com). A new completion date in February is on Nassau County's update reflecting an improvement of sixty days. An earlier completion date is anticipated as the contractor G&M Earth Moving, Inc. continues to perform ahead of the posted schedule.

ON MONDAY AUGUST 7TH, CLEFT ROAD OVER BEAVER DAM WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN 6:00 AM TO 7:00 AM FOR THE FISH LADDER PROJECT.

They continue to install the curbing and sidewalk. If you see any suspicious activity after working hours, you are asked to notify the Old Brookville Police Department at (516)626-1300. Railings will be installed on top of the cap. Native plantings will be installed after the curbing and railing is completed and topsoil is put down.

West Shore Road will be open **DURING NON-WORKING HOURS**. During the workweek, the road open schedule will be in accordance with the schedule below. The posted speed limit is 20 MPH, due to this phase still being an active construction zone. Traffic tickets issued will result in fines that will be doubled. Police will be enforcing the speed limit for safety of all involved.

- The stop light at West Shore Road and Cleft Road is operational. A reminder there is No Right Turn on red from Cleft Road.
- **7:00-3:30 Southbound Lane of West Shore Rd- will be open but there may be short delays when concrete trucks are positioned for pouring.**
- **7:00-3:30 Northbound Traffic on West Shore Rd- will use the Detour at Cleft Road.**
- **Cleft Road will have flagmen in the vicinity of Beaver Dam Spillway where one lane will be open with flagmen controlling the flow of traffic in both directions.**
- **A new fish ladder is being installed which will require three additional weeks. Signs are posted.**
- National Grid will be paving the area they disturbed on Creek Lane.
- G & M will not be working this weekend.
- For the resident's information, any time the Bayville Bridge is not passable, emergency services are notified to ensure timely responses by Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services.
