

# VILLAGE OF MILL NECK WEST SHORE ROAD UPDATE

Phase III

September 8, 2017

The Third and final phase of the West Shore Road project is under way. The plans for the project are posted on the Village's website ([www.millneckvillage.com](http://www.millneckvillage.com)). A new completion date in February is on Nassau County's update reflecting an improvement of sixty days. An earlier completion date is anticipated as the contractor G&M Earth Moving, Inc. continues to perform ahead of the posted schedule.

**They continue to grade, install the curbing, sidewalks and putting the soil down for the plantings. (See photo) Railing installation continues. Native plantings will be installed after the curbing and railing is completed.**

West Shore Road will be open **DURING NON-WORKING HOURS**. During the workweek, the road open schedule will be in accordance with the schedule below. The posted speed limit is 20 MPH, due to this phase still being an active construction zone. Traffic tickets issued will result in fines that will be doubled. Police will be enforcing the speed limit for safety of all involved.

- The stop light at West Shore Road and Cleft Road is operational. A reminder there is No Right Turn on red from Cleft Road.
- During the work days next week, the road will be closed during the following schedule:

9:00 AM – 3:30 PM SOUTH BOUND LANE

7:00 AM – 3:30 PM NORTH BOUND LANE

Residents who live on The Concourse and north of The Concourse will go north.

Residents who live south of The Concourse will go south.

- **Nassau County has communicated with the school district and buses are operating without any problems.**
- **G & M will not be working this weekend.**
- For the resident's information, any time the Bayville Bridge is not passable, emergency services are notified to ensure timely responses by Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services.
- If you see any suspicious activity after working hours, you are asked to notify the Old Brookville Police Department at (516)626-1300.
- **A special shout out to Donna Boyle who has been the Nassau County Engineer on all three phases of the West Shore Rd Project. After many years of service to Nassau County, she will be retiring this month. She has been a pleasure to work with.**
