

## An update for our neighbors in Oyster Bay

### We're making improvements to the natural gas system to provide better service to the community

In the coming weeks, National Grid and Asplundh Construction Corp, will be working to replace over 2,545 ft of gas main as well as upgrading 29 individual customer's service lines along; Richard Pl, Lake Ave, Renville Ct, Ski Ln.

Energy plays a critical role in our day-to-day lives and ensures the well-being of our community. That's why we are investing in infrastructure upgrades that will help us to provide safe and reliable natural gas to our customers for years to come.

We anticipate that the duration of the entire project will be approximately four months.



#### What you may expect during construction:

- The safety of the public and our crews is our first priority. Please use caution around our construction zones, and pay attention to traffic cones, cone bars and barricades
- Crews will generally work between the hours of 8am-5pm
- We anticipate no road closures. However motorists can expect lane shifts, merging traffic and slight delays. Traffic signs will be posted and flaggers positioned when required
- All businesses will remain open and accessible for the duration of the project

A \$1,000 incentive may be available to upgrade to Natural Gas. If you are interested in having a gas service brought to your home for gas heat or a gas appliance now is the time to act while we are on your street improving the gas system.

\*\$1,000 incentive only applies to new customers who add a gas service line while natural gas improvements are being made on your street.
